

Clarion Hospital EMS Ambulance Subscription Terms and Conditions

Your subscription to Clarion Hospital Emergency Medical Service entitles you and eligible household members to prehospital emergency care by professional Paramedics and EMT's and medically necessary non-emergency interfacility transportation as defined by insurance guidelines. Subscription fees do not cover the actual cost of service. Acceptance of insurance reimbursement when a member uses the service covers some of the cost and allows us to keep the membership fee more affordable for everyone. Please be aware that your subscription does not cover any deductibles that are charged by your insurance company. Deductibles are your responsibility to pay.

## What are the benefits?

- Reduced ambulance rate of 25% if your insurance company denies payment as "not medically necessary"
- Reduced rate of 10%, if your insurance does not pay if you decide to decline further transportation or treatment after initial response.
  - Correct insurance information is required to bill your insurance
  - Treat No Transport Act 103 of 2018
- Includes the first 10 miles at no cost if you choose to go to a facility that is not the closest to you.
- Subscriber rate for alternative transportation not covered by insurance (Wheelchair Van) base rate is \$20.00 versus \$30.00.

We sincerely hope that you or your family never needs us, but if you do, being a subscriber to Clarion Hospital Emergency Medical Service could save you hundreds of dollars in ambulance bills.
